A rare blend of grapes producing intense aromas and vegetal flavours. Herbal with striking fruits and spice, but beautifully balanced. Farmyard in a bottle.

A classic and elegant Provencal blend made from 25 year old vines, it embodies everything that makes the region such a stand-out one when it comes to pink wine. Expect flavours of ripe peach, apricot, and red raspberry along with orange blossom and spice.
